MARKING SYSTEM

All grades are numerical. A grade of 65 is required for passing all courses or New York State Regents Exams. Final averages are based on a total of five marks (three for semester-long courses) - the four report period's grades plus a final exam. Class ranks are calculated at the completion of the 6, and then 7th Semester for students graduating in June. All students are ranked together with no separation of Regents and Non-Regents. Courses are only weighted for ranking purposes using a detailed system. Please contact the counseling office if you need more information.
