## What is PageTurners?

PageTurners is a literature-based competition for students in grades 3-12. Teams of six students prepare to answer questions by reading the books on the Official List of Titles, which is prepared by a committee of teachers, coaches, and librarians.

Teams compete in a round robin format with nearby schools, and division winners advance to a region-wide final tournament.

The purpose of the competition is to encourage and reward reading skills and to provide recognition to students for their accomplishments in reading.
