More Information Related to the Costs of Chromebook Repair, Replacement, and Insurance:

Students will be issued a laptop computer with a carrying case. Students are given a training course and we expect that the computers will treated in a respectful manner. This is very similar to the way students are issued textbooks. We do not anticipate there will be damage to the laptop, but want you to have all the information ahead of time in terms of options you have if the laptop is damaged.

The retail value of the Google Chromebook laptop computer is \$240. This is the "worst case scenario" if you were to have to purchase a new computer.

You may wish to purchase insurance. The District has a relationship with the Worth Avenue Group so parents can purchase accidental damage coverage for \$45 per year (full coverage with no deductible). The family works directly with the insurance company under this arrangement. See the attached sheet for more information on insurance. Another option for insurance is to see if you can add this to your homeowner's insurance policy. If may be cheaper than the Worth Ave. Group policy, but it may not cover breakage or cracked screens, and be sure to check the deductible you are responsible for.

A second option is investigating the cost of getting the unit repaired on your own. This may be a less expensive option than the repair we can offer. We have a relationship with Notebook Tek on Main St. in Geneseo if you would like to see if they can fix the laptop for you. This is the only outside vendor that we will accept repair work from. If the repair entails nothing more than replacing a cracked screen, we can do that in-house for \$40.

Students will not be issued a replacement laptop while the initial laptop is being repaired.

The machine must be repaired or replaced before the student graduates or leaves York Central School. Diplomas are held until all outstanding bills are settled.
