Shared AP class

AP History class is going well. Some early issues with audio quality have been resolved. The committee asked for the bell schedules to be aligned next year to expand AP offerings. The committee also inquired about the cost of adding a second Distance Learning cart. The current fee for this addition would be: \$11,000 per district.

SAT review class

A shared SAT prep course was held in September. Students from PCS and YCS attended the program. The course focused on test taking strategies and was well received overall. In February an ACT prep course will be offered and once again PCS and YCS will share.

Fall sports update/other

Jim Sattora and Ed Orman reported out regarding the success the fall season program shares. This season Football, Soccer and X-Country were all merged teams. This allowed all programs to have sufficient numbers to operate. The students from both schools are making positive connections and are exploring non-athletic options to share. Shared dances and Open Mic nights are two such examples.

The merged modified & varsity wrestling programs will be in their third year and the shared youth wrestling program will be in its second year. The committee will meet later in the year to discuss spring sport options once student sign ups occur. The committee agreed to authorize the ADs and superintendents to move forward with sharing of spring sports if there is good reason and our criteria for sharing sports are met.
